

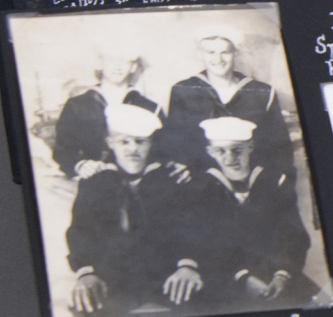

Roy and his naval buddies. He is in the top left

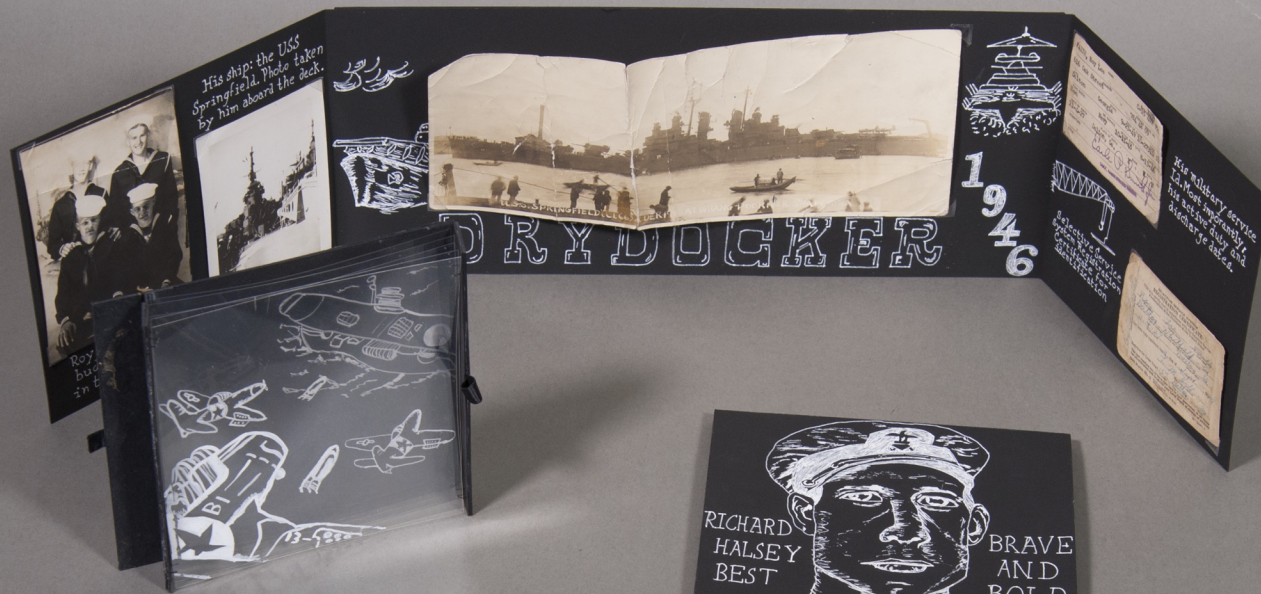
His ship: the USS Springfield. Photo taken by him aboard the deck.

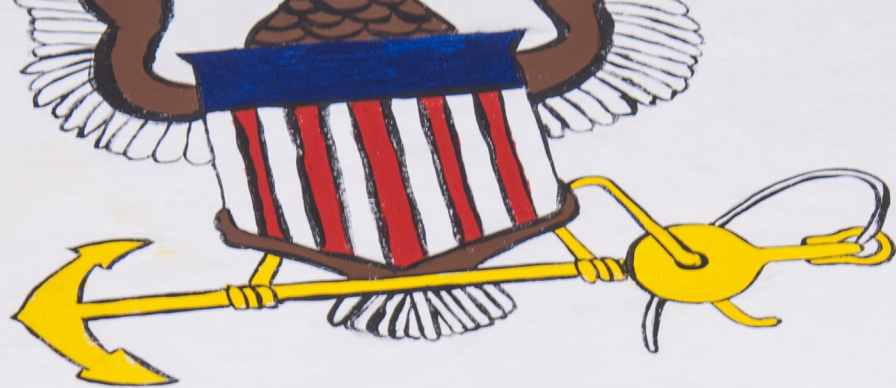

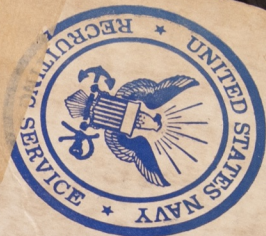
