Dear Lester:

When the final grant was made for the Community Art Project in Providence in 1937, I wrote to the President of the Carnegie Corporation explaining that Brown University would continue to lend its support to this undertaking.

I write now to say that this support has now been discontinued not because of lack of funds but because of what might be called occupational fatigue in cooperation. I deeply regret this and feel that it is a marked step backwards for both institutions.
