

"Japanese military comfort women" refer to women who were forced into sexual slavery for the Japanese military in "comfort stations" from 1931 to 1945 when Japan was defeated in the Pacific War.

The ages of "comfort women" were around 10 to 25. The number of comfort women is estimated at 400,000 and Korean women comprised more than half. The issue was cloacked for decades until the first testimocny of Kim Haksun in 1991.
