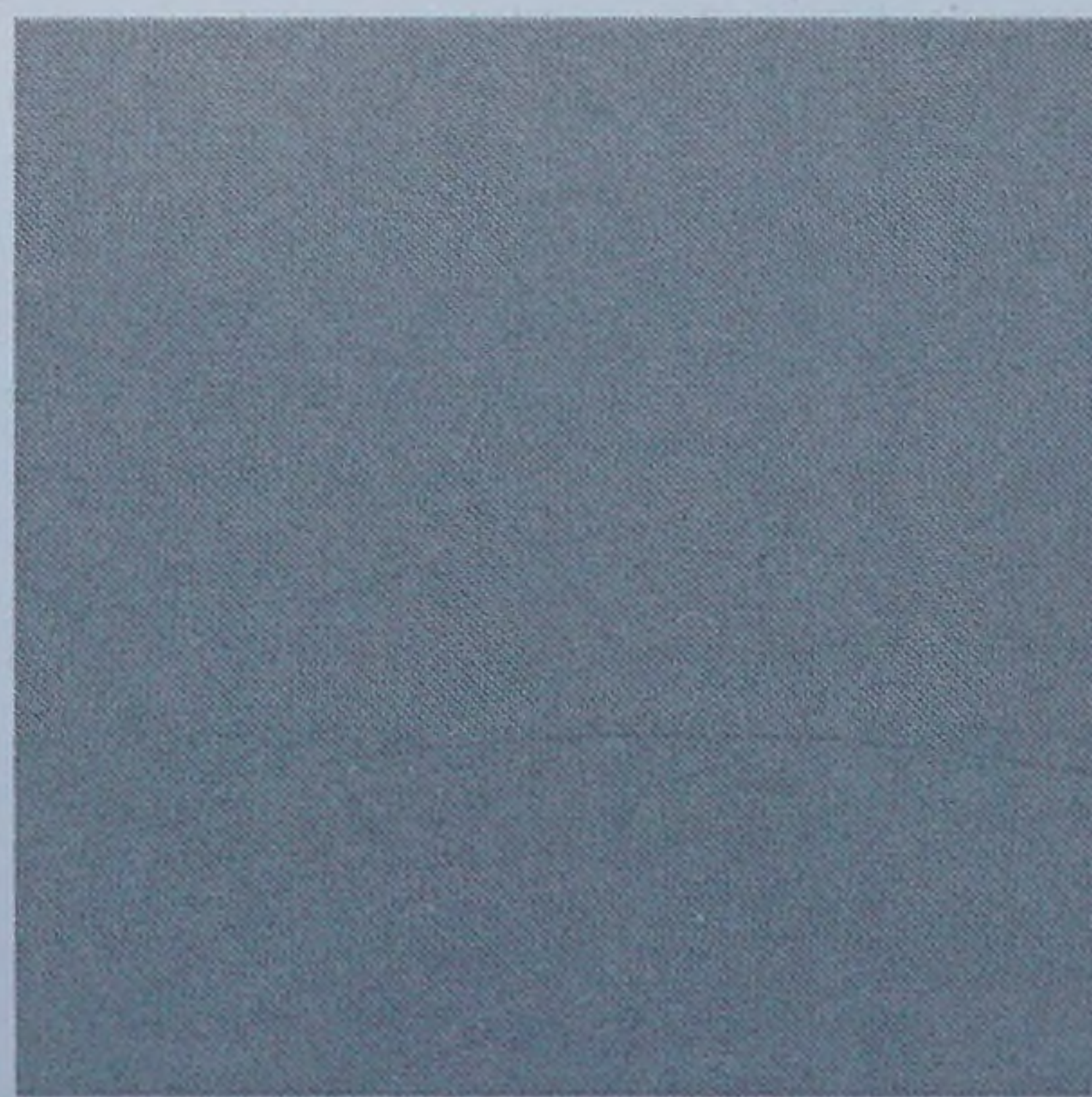
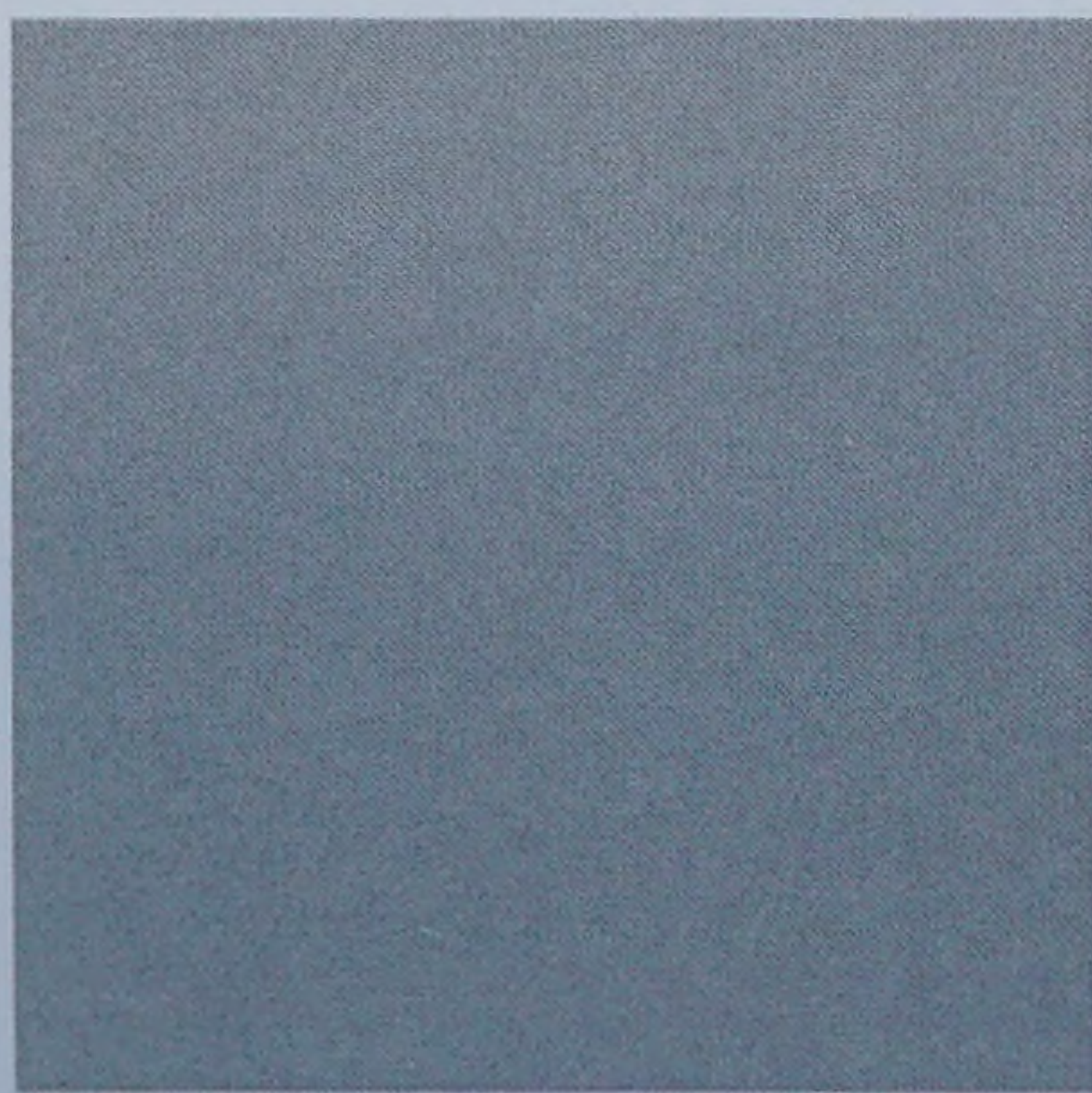
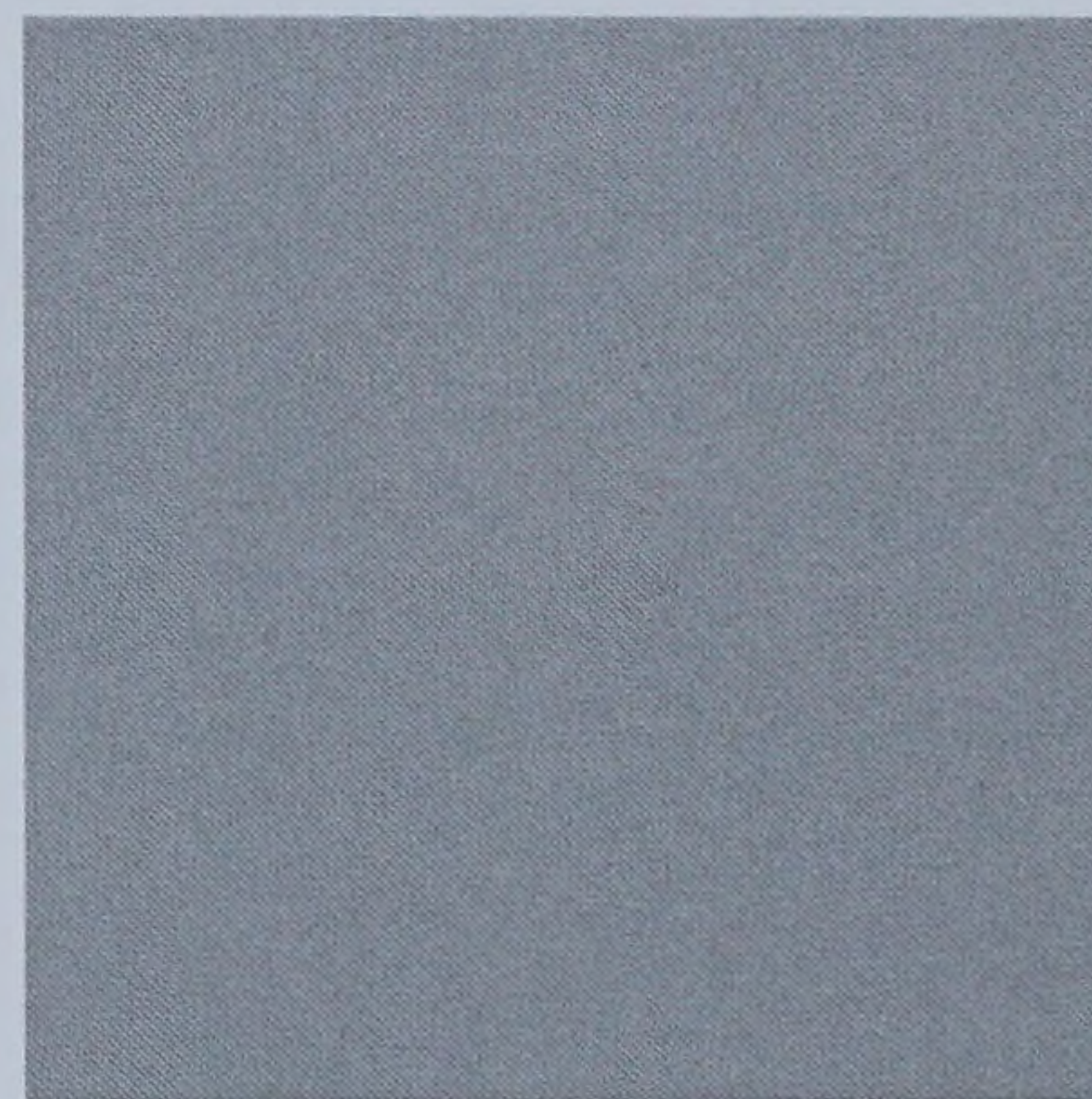
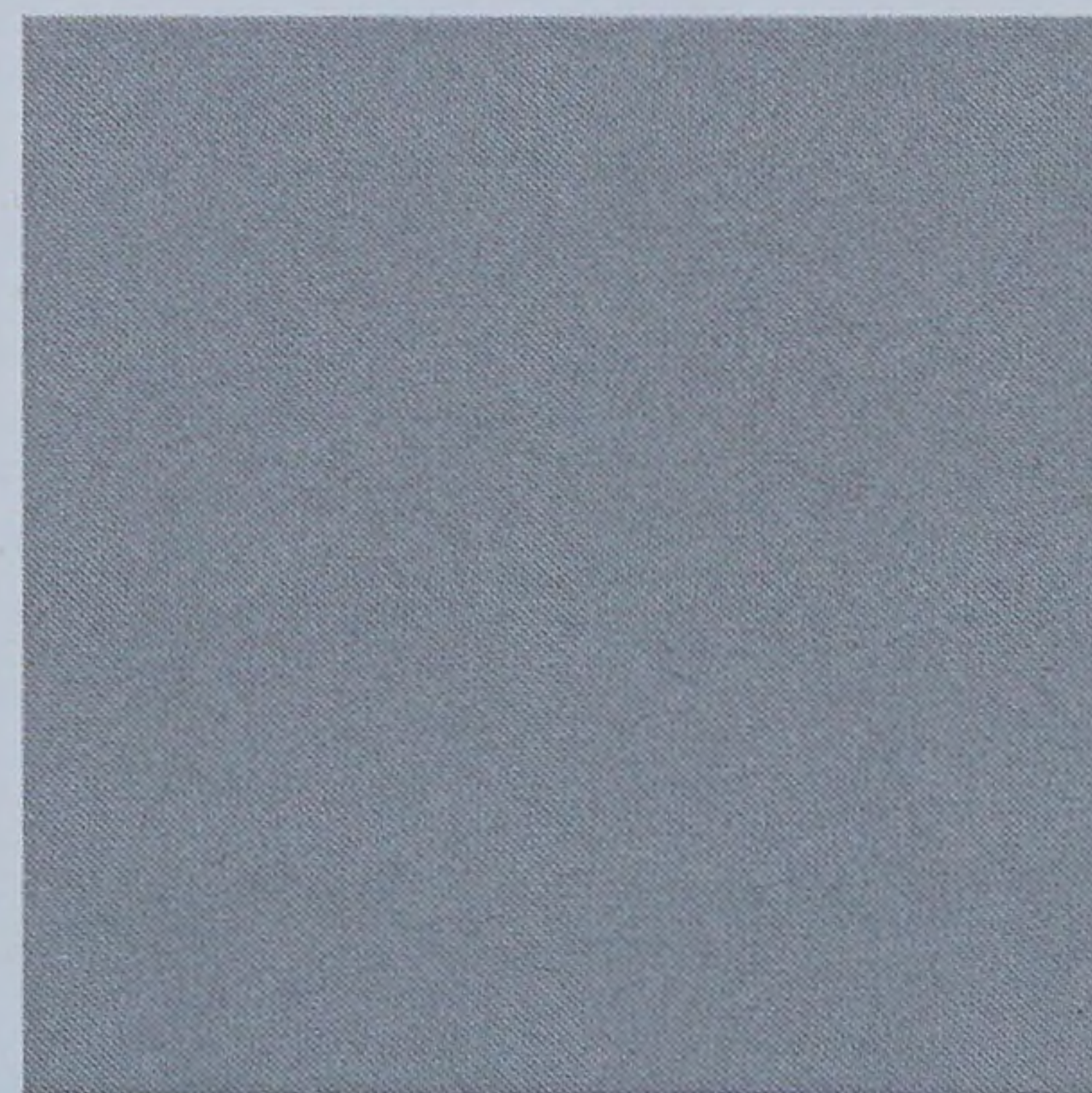
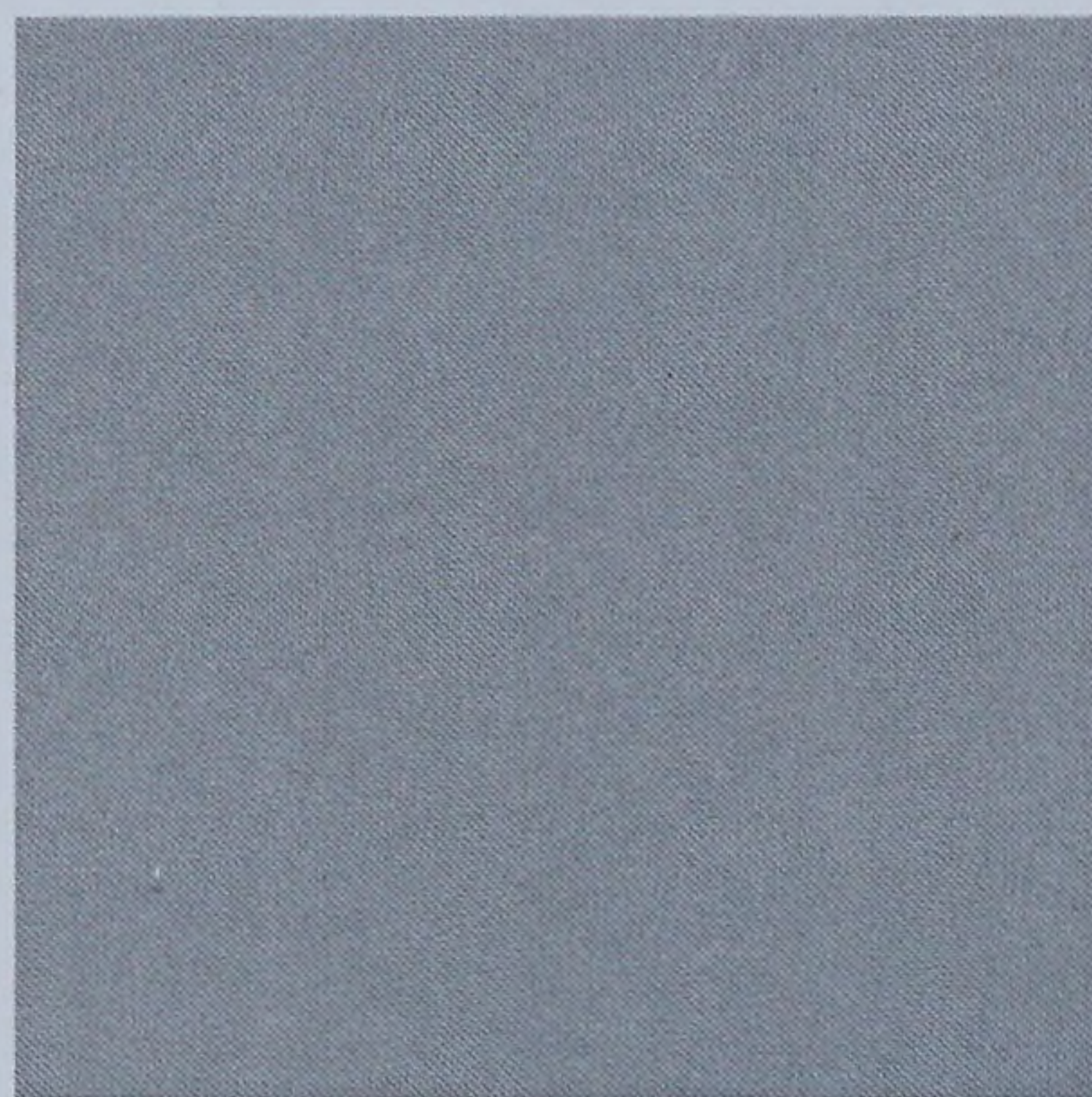
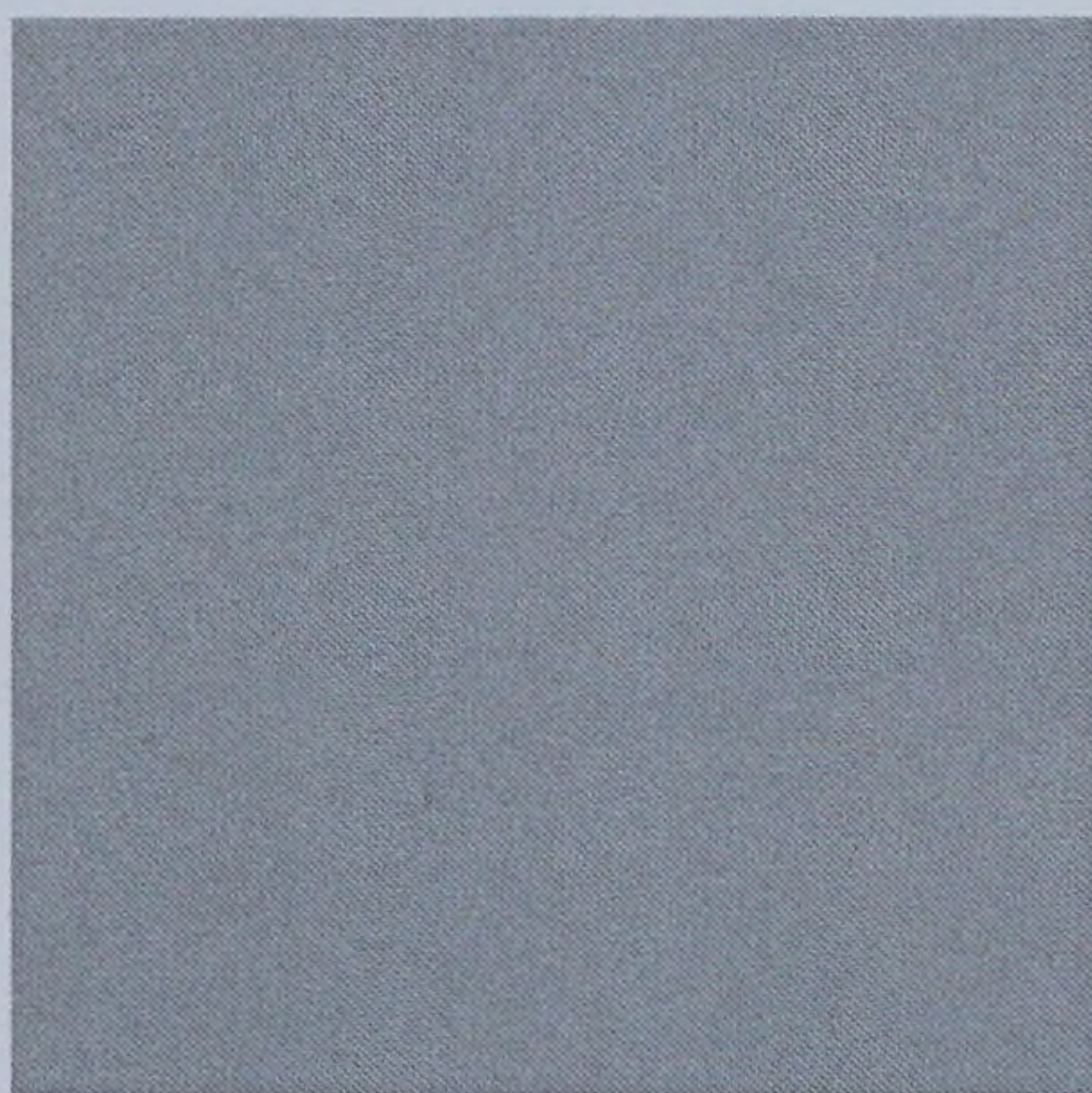
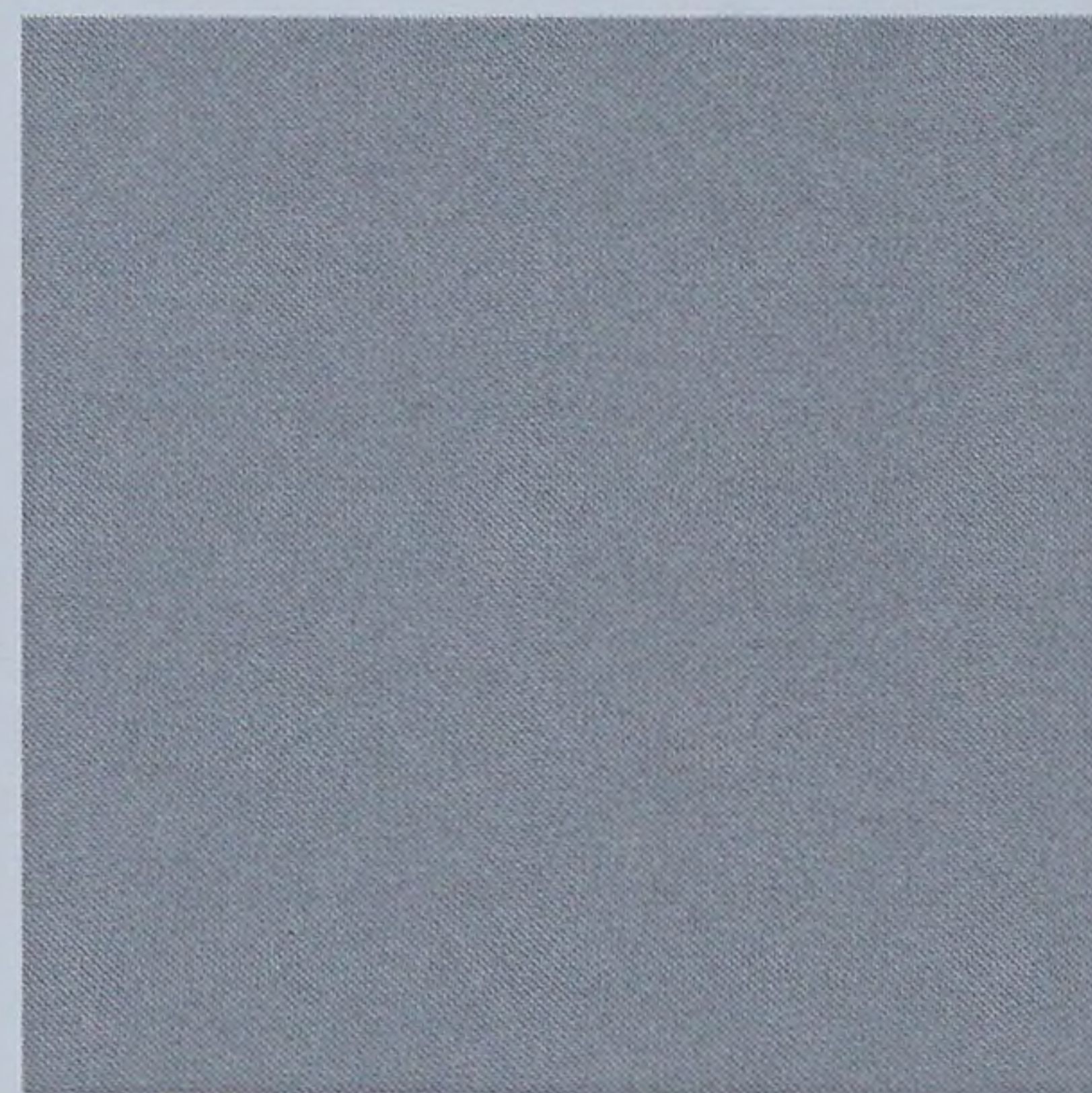
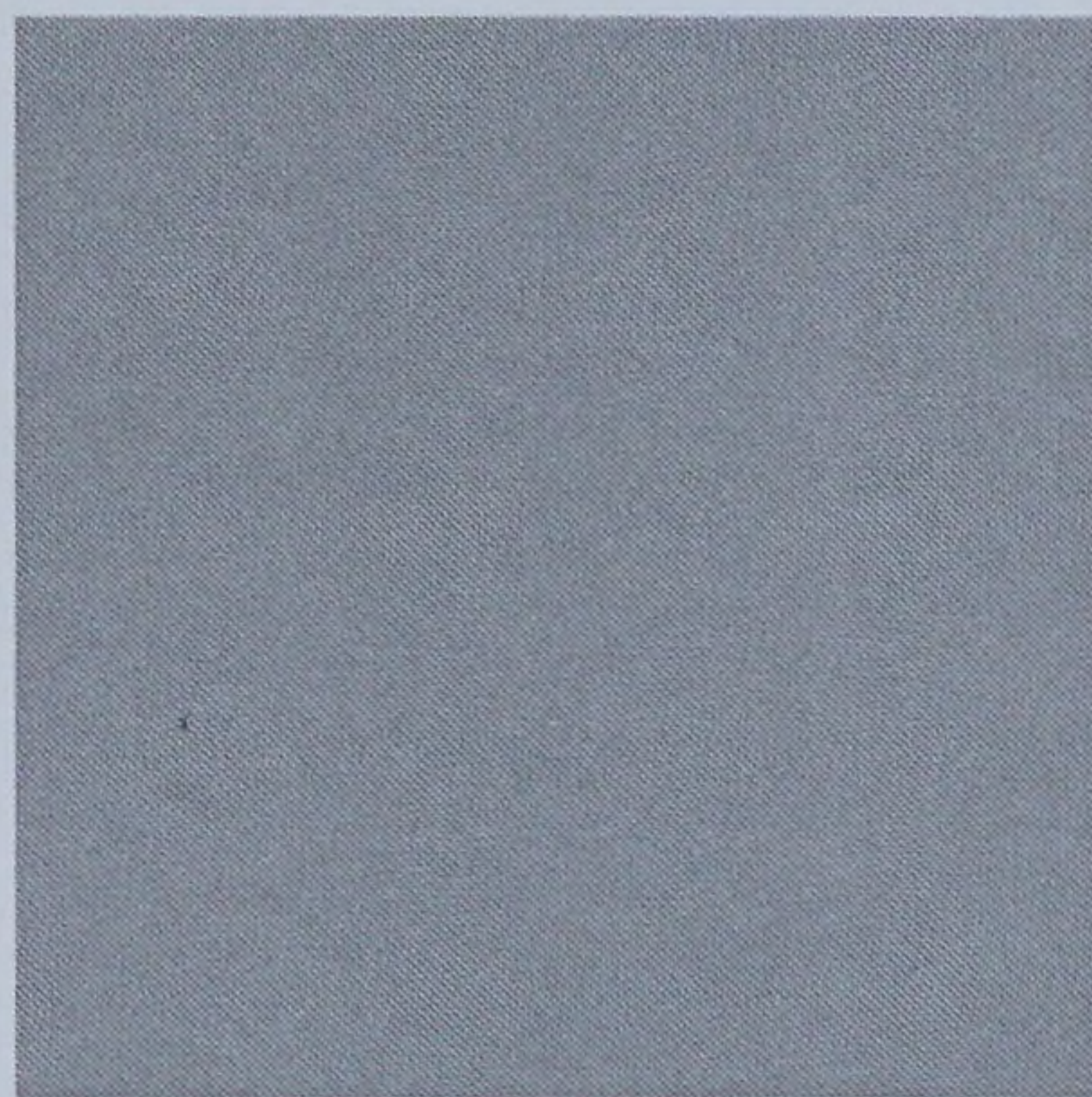
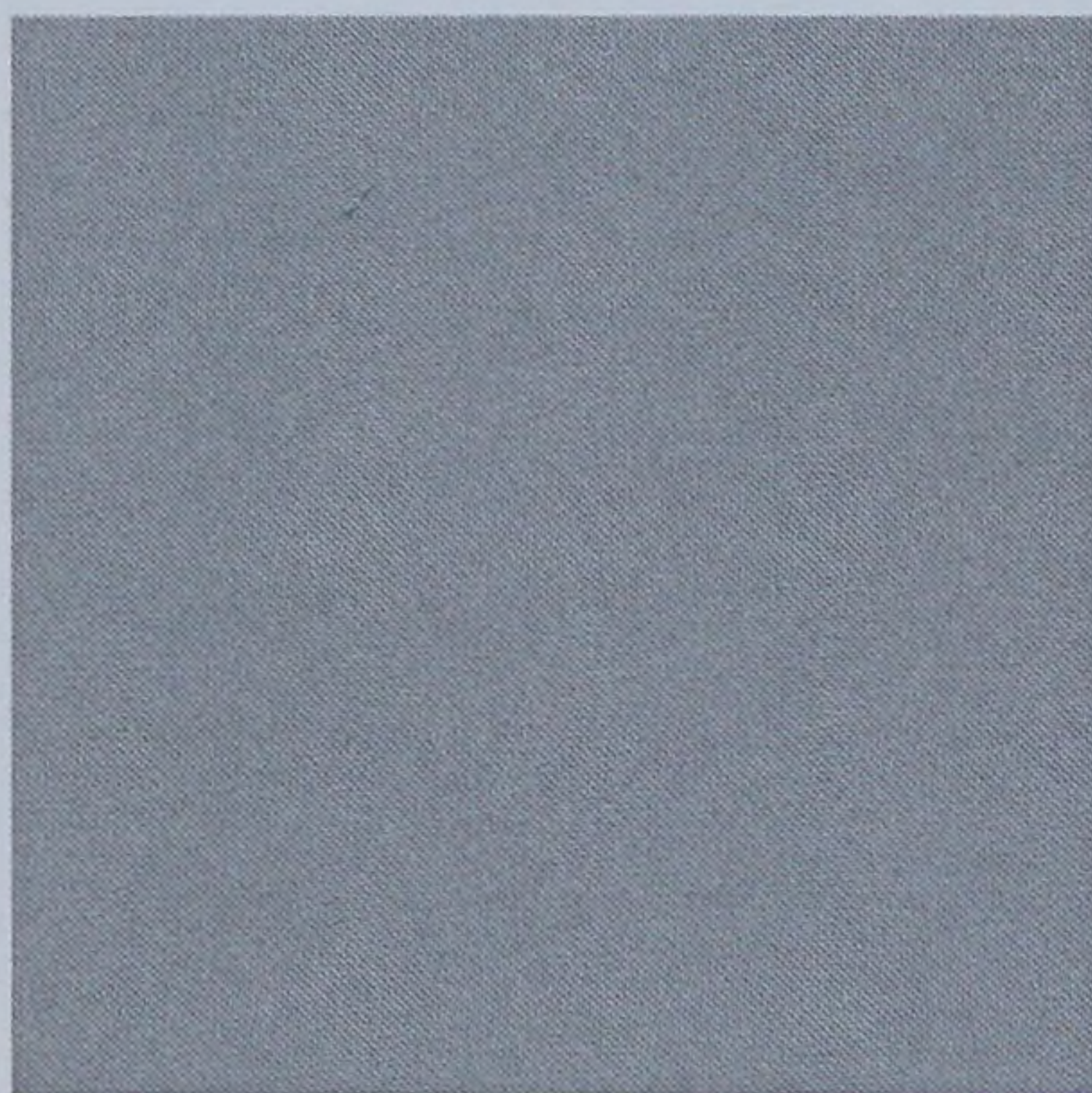
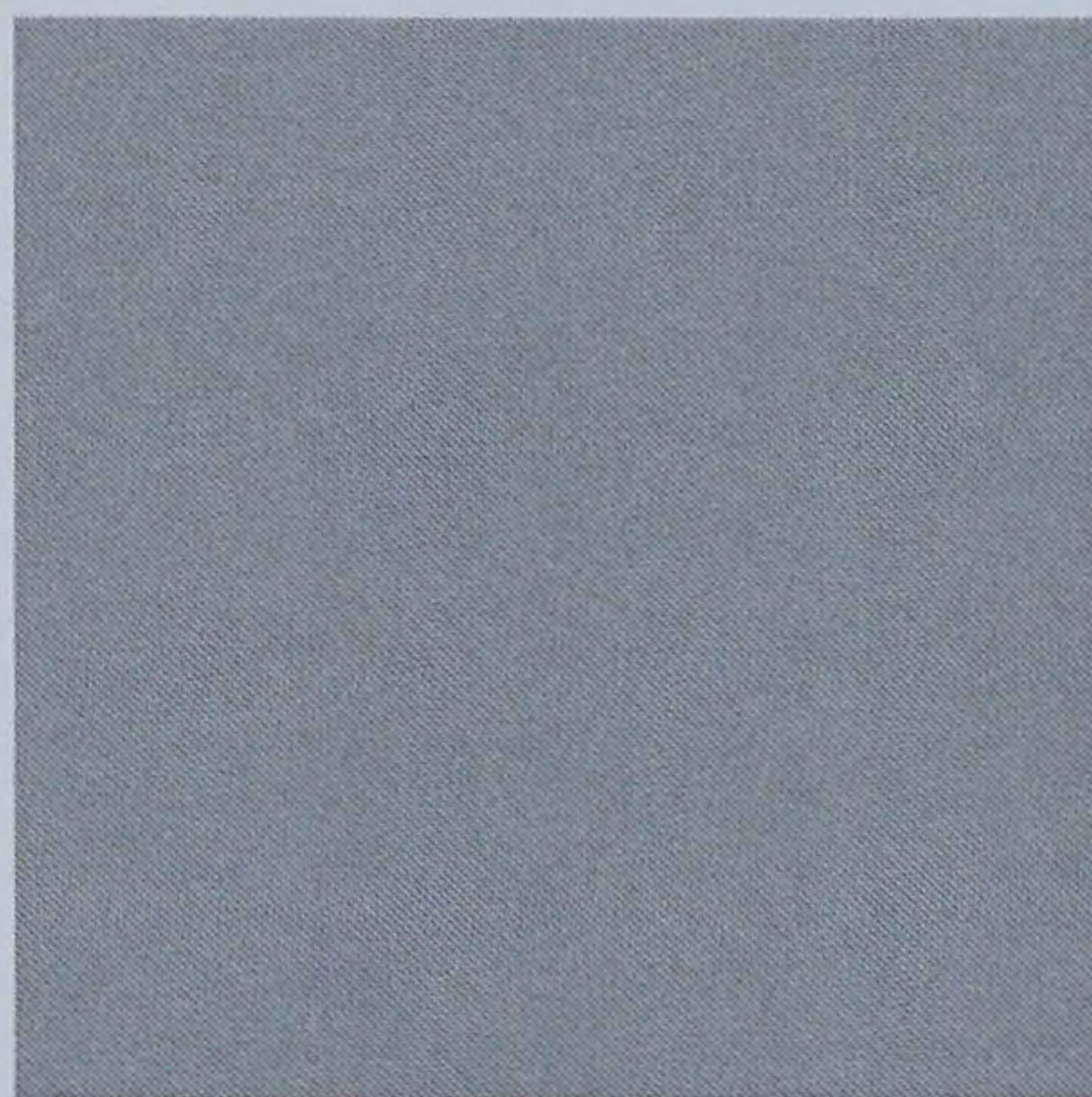
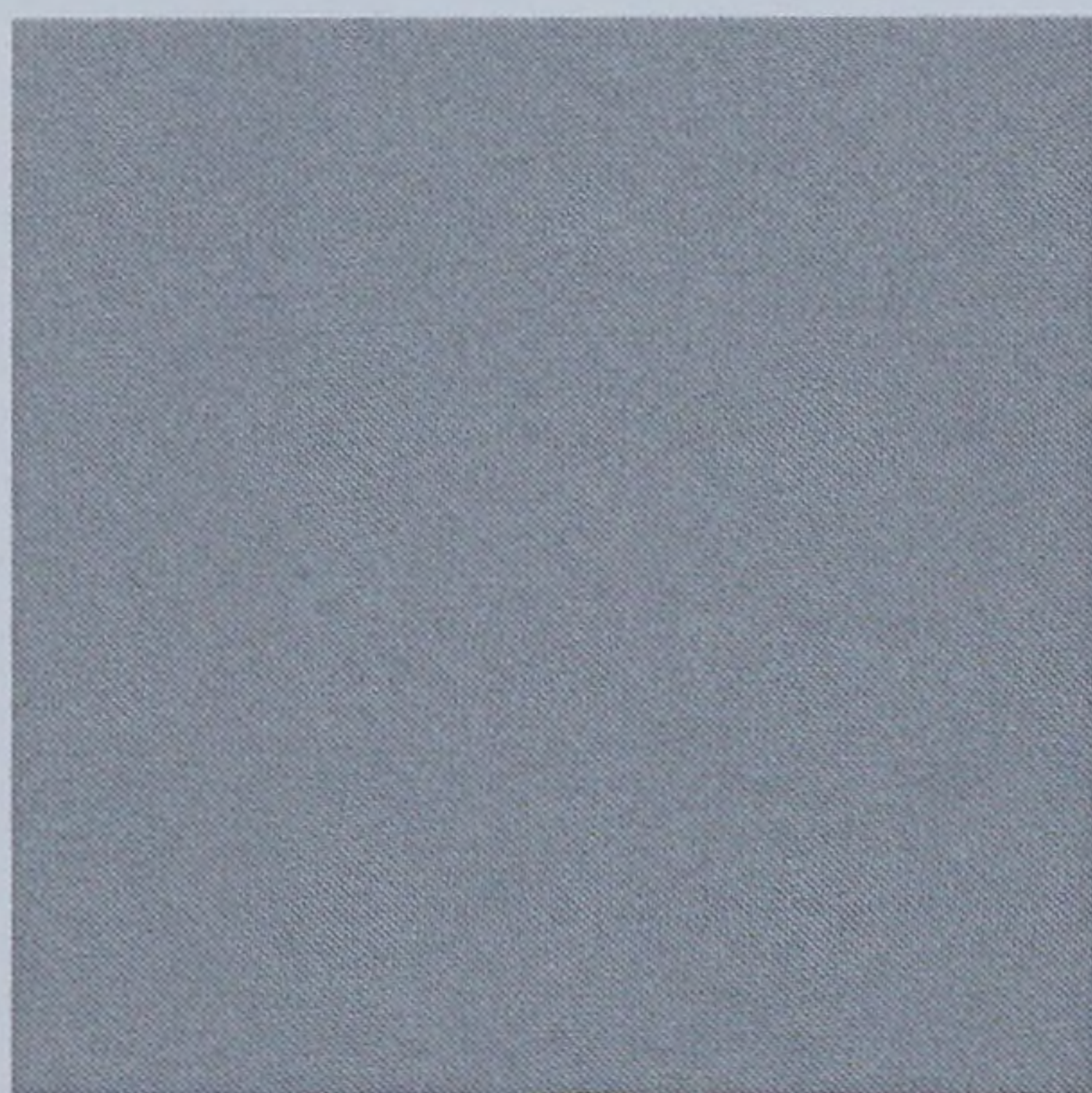
perhaps... the white wines from the vineyards on the islands of the bays that pour into our Seekonk, our Woonasquatucket, our Moshassuk streams and creeks.


RISD Friends,

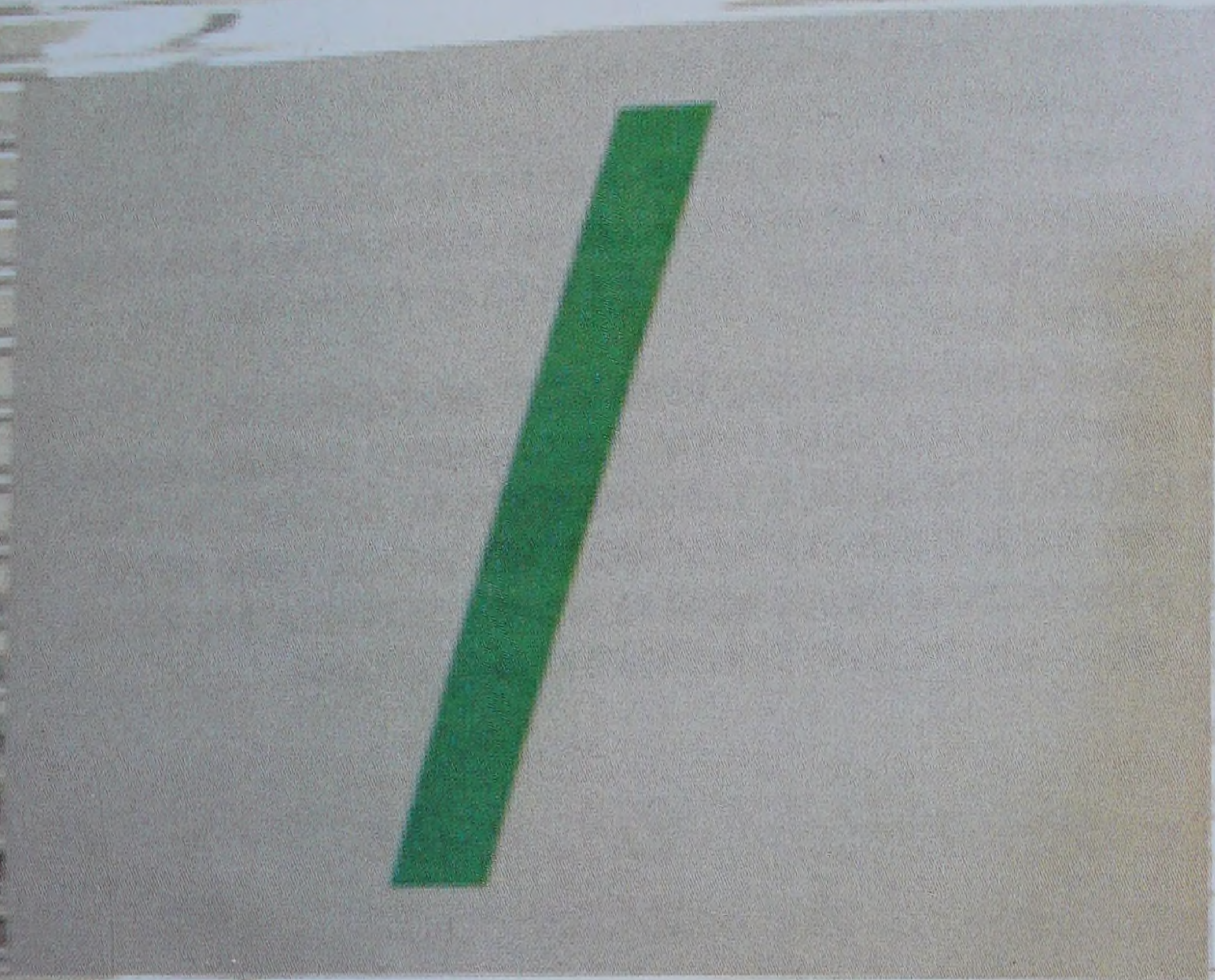
Dear Class,
