

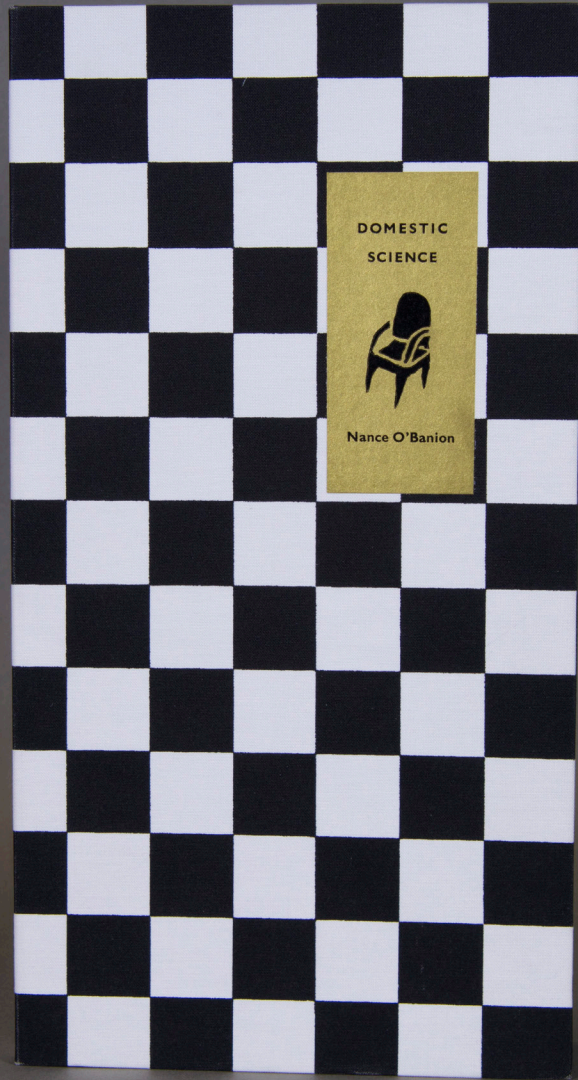

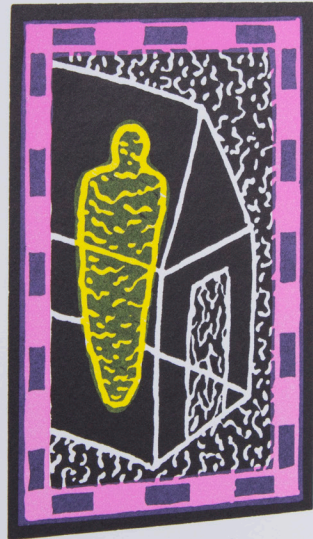

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PREFACE

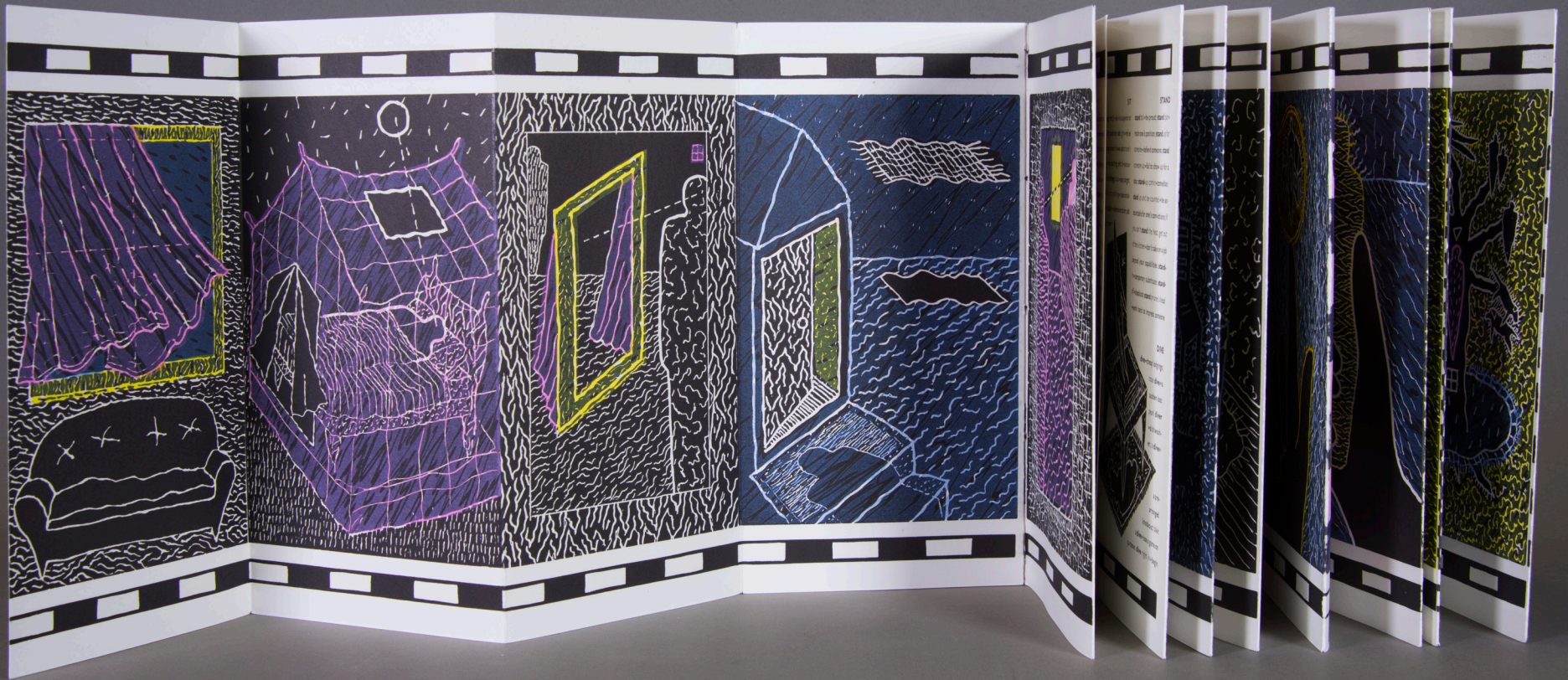
An **idiom** is a combination of words with special meaning that cannot be inferred from a translation of its separate parts. **Domestic Science: Idioms** investigates the effect of context on meaning and explores how images, like words in an idiom, can be combined and presented to communicate ideas which transcend their individual meanings. Simple mundane terms and objects of everyday life become colorful metaphors for psychosocial conditions when viewed through the reader's personal experience.

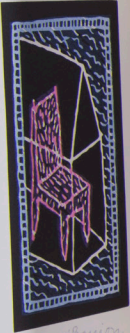
