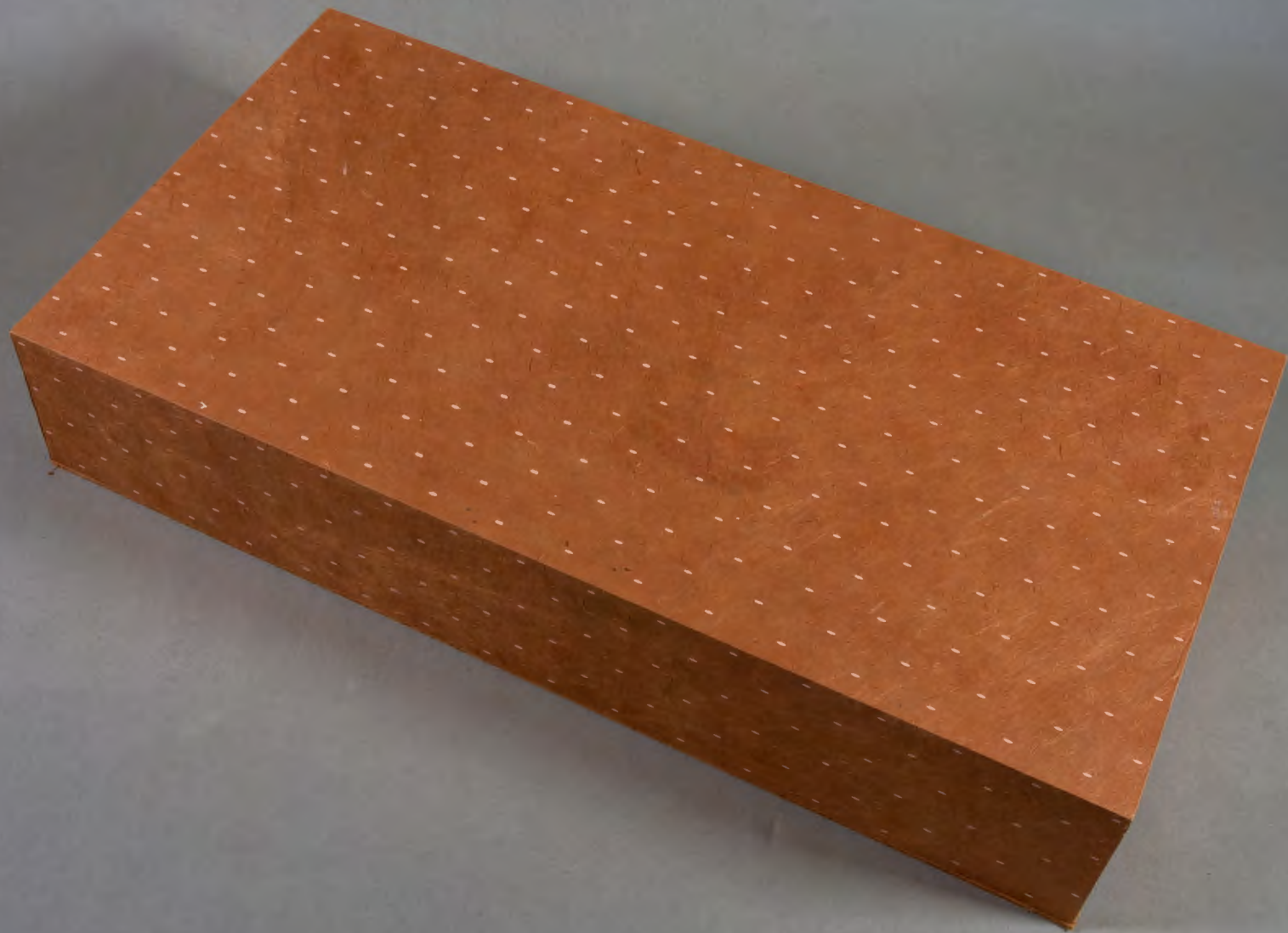
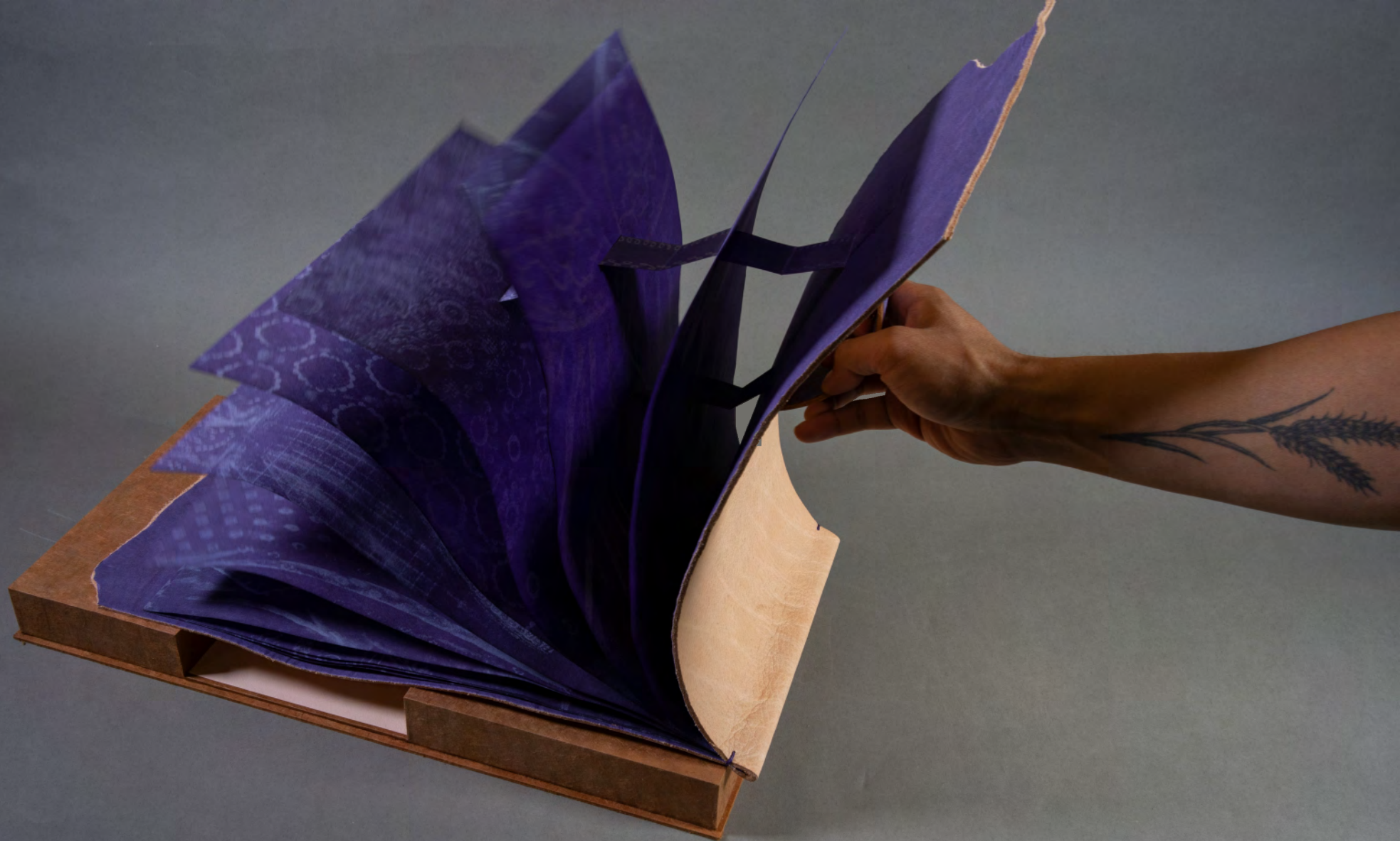

Clothing retains the story of the wearer.

In Fashioning Bookwalter and Running capture personally significant garments in direct crayon rubbings. The drawn marks reveal the garments' embellishments and structure and physically capture a moment in the life of the textile. Each garment contains evidence of the hands that made it and the bodies that wore it. The drawings were transferred to letterpress printing plates, printed in white ink, resit dyed, and waxed to become the pages of a book structure the reader wears. Fashioning is a tactile experience embedded in paper and encased in leather. To read the book please put your hands into the cover handles and open your arms.
