Created because it had to be, 70 x 7 became my way of understanding and processing the tumultuous changes that occurred at the unexpected ending of a second marriage. It was developed from notes and journals of thoughts during two years following the incident. This book has three layers of tests the main pages which are primarily nonverbal, the strips threaded through the book which serve as conflicting voices in my head, and the small border images. If the text is confusing and slow to read, it is because that's how it felt. If the images are a bit ambiguous, it is because there were multiple readings to every thought. While there should be a good deal of mystery in an artist's book to allow you to project your own story, a full set of text from the strips and some explanation of the images is available at the Women's Studio Workshop upon request.

The process of printing was Indigo digital printing on Arches and letterpress on Lana Royale and Rives BFK. Imagery is all original photography processed through Adobe Photoshop on a Power Macintosh. In this edition 50 copies were printed on Arches (numbers 1-50), and another 40 copies were printed on 80 lb. acid free Champion Carnival (numbers 51-90).
